An Honors Option should allow a student within a course, in conjunction with the course instructor, to design and complete a challenging project that delves more deeply into some aspect of the course content. This project should be an extension of what is done normally in class, not a substitution for regularly required course work. It may be an additional, discrete project or an expansion upon an existing course project, thus enhancing the quality of the student's educational experience. Consequently, just repeating an assignment would not qualify as an Honors Option. Doing first-hand research, rather than second-hand research, would. The instructor and the student will meet periodically throughout the semester to discuss the student's progress toward completion of the Honors Option Project.
