Surgical technologists are key members of the team that assist in surgeries. They work closely with surgeons, registered nurses, anesthesiologists, and other hospital personnel. They work with surgical equipment, help prepare medications, assist in retracting tissues from the patient, pass the surgical tools to the surgeon and surgical assistant during the operation, set up the operating room, and prepare the patient and transportation.
