This survey was conducted by the Center for Community Studies at SUNY Jefferson November 6-8, 2025, among 972 adult residents of New York State. All 972 respondents were contacted by text messages with survey links included using cellular phones provided by Aristotle. Data were weighted to balance sample demographics to match estimates for New York State's population using data from the Census Bureau's 2023 U.S. American Community Survey (ACS): age, region in state, race/ethnicity, education, and gender to ensure representativeness. The study has an overall margin of error of +/- 3.8 percentage points including the design effects resulting from weighting. Sampling error is only one of many potential sources of error and there may be other unmeasured error in this or any other public opinion poll. The Center for Community Studies, directed by Mr. Joel LaLone, conducts public opinion research primarily in Northern NYS. CCS, an independent, non-partisan research institute, subscribes to the American Association of Public Opinion Research Code of Professional Ethics and Practices.
